VOCALS / GUITAR

Matt is Probably Fine's lead singer, guitarist and principal songwriter. His worn, expressive voice carries songs built from the things people almost say: late-night conversations, shared rooms and the small gestures that change a friendship. His guitar leaves room for the rhythm section before opening into the band's raw, full-weight choruses.



Jamie

DRUMS

A founding member and the band's drummer from the beginning, Jamie gives Probably Fine its physical drive. Her playing is lean, forceful and precise, with a deep pocket and a feel for exactly when a song needs to break open. Offstage, her dry humor and directness are part of the same instinct: she knows when something rings true.



Jimmy

BASS

Jimmy supplies the band's weight, patience and melodic foundation. His unhurried bass lines hold the trio together while leaving space for the others to move. A lifelong friend of Matt and Jamie, he also helps keep their aging van on the road. His presence is steady; his contributions are unmistakable.

Matt, Jamie and Jimmy grew up together in Longview, Washington. Music began as one more shared plan and became the one they kept showing up for. After an early four-piece incarnation ended, the founding trio found its voice in distorted guitar, thick melodic bass, physical drums and songs drawn from the lives they share.

Their name captures their sense of humor: a reassurance with a little uncertainty still attached. That same combination runs through the music, where everyday frustrations give way to moments of unexpected tenderness.

An introduction already lived in

"Probably Fine" introduces the band through rehearsal-room mishaps, life in the van and the quiet work of keeping one another going. Its closing exchange brings the song back to the room: "How's that sound?" "Probably fine."

Both "Probably Fine" and the forthcoming follow-up, "Mascara on My Best Friend," were written before the B.N.G. signing. The partnership brings that existing material to the screen through the band's first official music videos. "Mascara on My Best Friend" will follow with a more intimate story of friendship and changing feelings.
